

GOLF ETIQUETTE

Dress code:

- Wear a shirt, pants or shorts and shoes
- No ripped or inappropriate clothing
- Golf shoes recommended or flat sole shoes. (shoes with heels are not acceptable)

Pace of Play:

- Keep up with the group ahead of you, not just in front of the group behind you.
- Play ready golf. Have your club ready as you wait for your partner.
- Always watch your ball until it comes to a stop.
- Play balls on the fairway. If the ball lands out of bounds (white stakes), pick up your ball and drop on the fairway. Do not play balls from within the RV park area.
- Don't search longer than two minutes for your ball.
- When chipping on the green, bring your putter.
- Leave the greens quickly; mark your score card at the next tee box.

Golf Cart rules:

- Drive slowly down the slopes and hills
- Avoid making sharp or quick turns
- Stay 30 feet away from the greens
- Never drive over tees or roped off areas
- Avoid driving on fairways. Stay on roughs and cart paths.
- No joy riding.
- Note: failing to follow the rules listed above could result in a warning and/or loss of cart rental. Anyone causing damage to golf course or carts will be removed from Golf Course and could be fined for damages. No refunds.

Alcohol consumption:

- Only alcohol purchased from Pipestone Links is allowed on the Golf Course. Individuals caught with outside liquor can be fined under the Alberta Liquor Laws Act 117.

Please note: All individual players are responsible for any damages made by their golf balls.
